## DATE NIGHT SKITTLE FUN INSTRUCTIONS

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**Materials Needed:** 

**Plate** 

**Skittles** 

Cup

Warm Water

### **Instructions:**

Line up skittles around the edge of a plate in a fun pattern.

Warm up some water in a glass and pour it in the middle of the plate slowly until it reaches the skittles.

Sit back, relax and watch the magic happen...

If you love this colorful experiment, try it again with a new pattern.



### Materials Needed:

**Straws** 

Dice

**Paper Plate** 

### **Instructions:**

Pour bag of skittles onto a plate, gather round in a circle. Give each player a straw.

First player rolls 2 dice, if they get doubles then they start "vacuuming" skittles by sucking them up with their straw.

Other players continue to roll dice, if a new player gets double, they will take over "vacuuming" up skittles.

The person with the most skittles when the skittles on the plate run out - wins!!
