

SCAVENGER HUNT BAG TEMPLATE

5 1/8 x 10 1/8

Use this template for printing on normal, lunch paper bags.

Simply print this template on a sheet of paper. You can either print off a template for each paper bag or re-use the same template.

Next, lightly adhere a paper bag to the template (making sure all corners are flat on the page.)

Finally, select the scavenger hunt design you are wanting to print onto your paper bag. Place your paper bag on the template back into the printer. (Make sure you know how your printer feeds so it doesn't print upside down!) Press print.









Thank You CARDS
