

# TIPS FOR SETTING UP

1. Encourage guests to dress up (anything fun or symbolic to the evening of LOVE!).
2. Clear the room of clutter so it's not too confusing. Some distracting pieces are okay.
3. Set clear rules for things that shouldn't be touched or moved.
4. Set expectations for playing in the spirit of the game. Encourage not jumping ahead or just guessing combinations. Decide if you want to allow participants to use Google to solve puzzles or not.
5. Explain that you can provide hints as desired, OR make a rule that guests can only receive up to 3 hints (for a more challenging experience).
6. Find clever places to hide the clues, such as taped to the backs of framed pictures, on the flip side of blinds, inside books, underneath tables, desks, or chairs.
7. Make sure to read all puzzles and clues (including details in the post!) to ensure you understand the order of events and details.



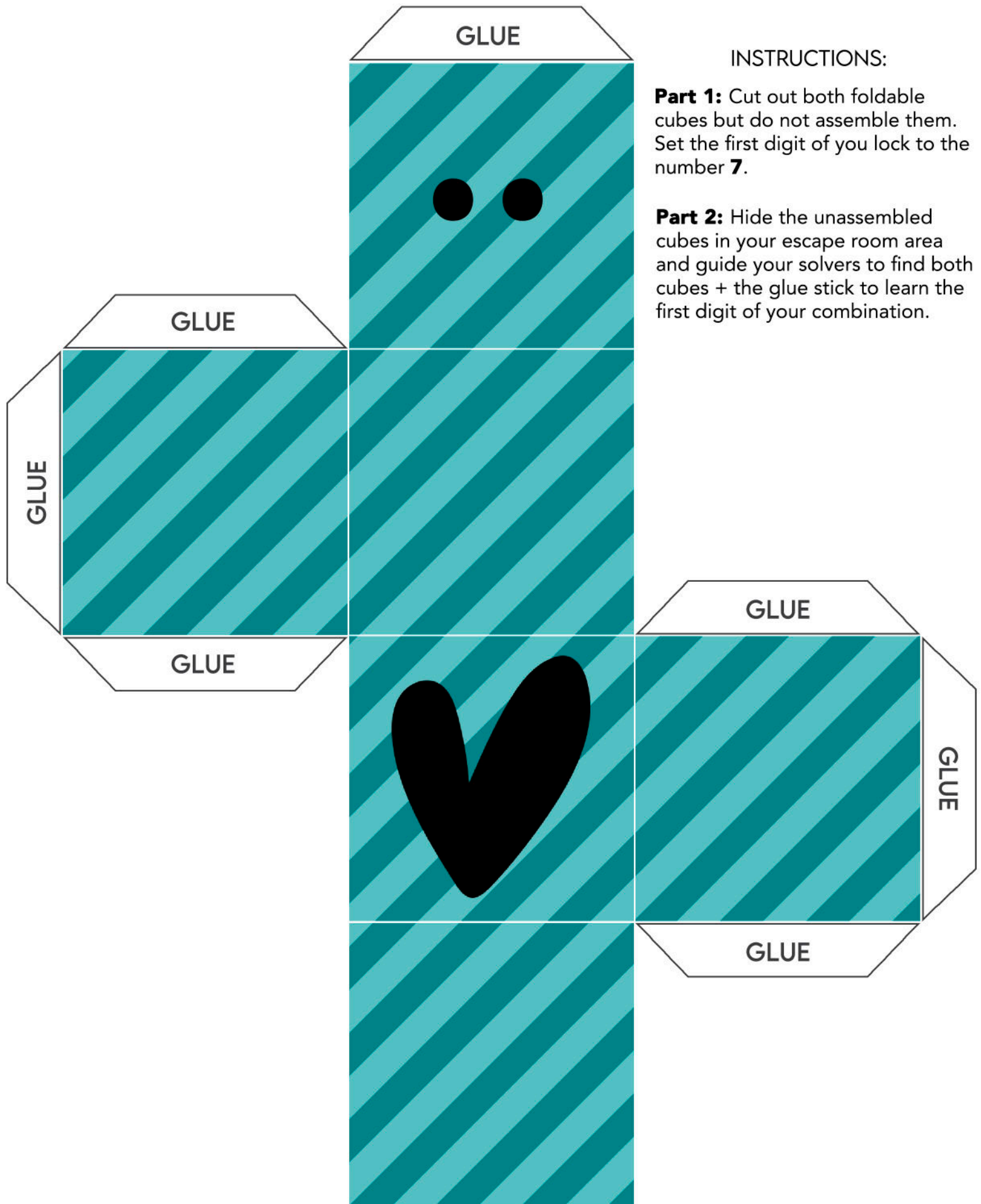

## PUZZLE #1 - FOLDABLE CUBES

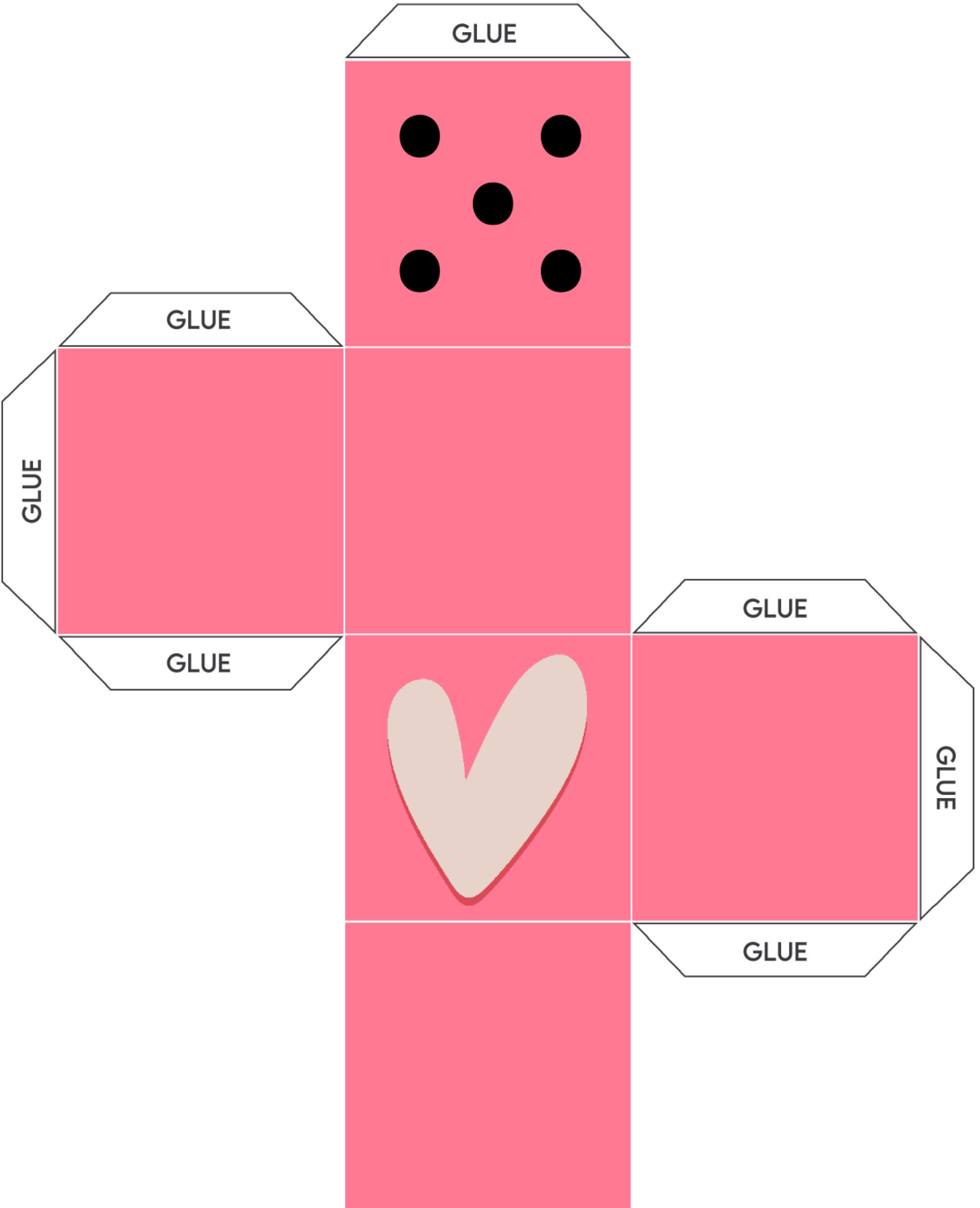


### INSTRUCTIONS:

**Part 1:** Cut out both foldable cubes but do not assemble them. Set the first digit of your lock to the number **7**.

**Part 2:** Hide the unassembled cubes in your escape room area and guide your solvers to find both cubes + the glue stick to learn the first digit of your combination.

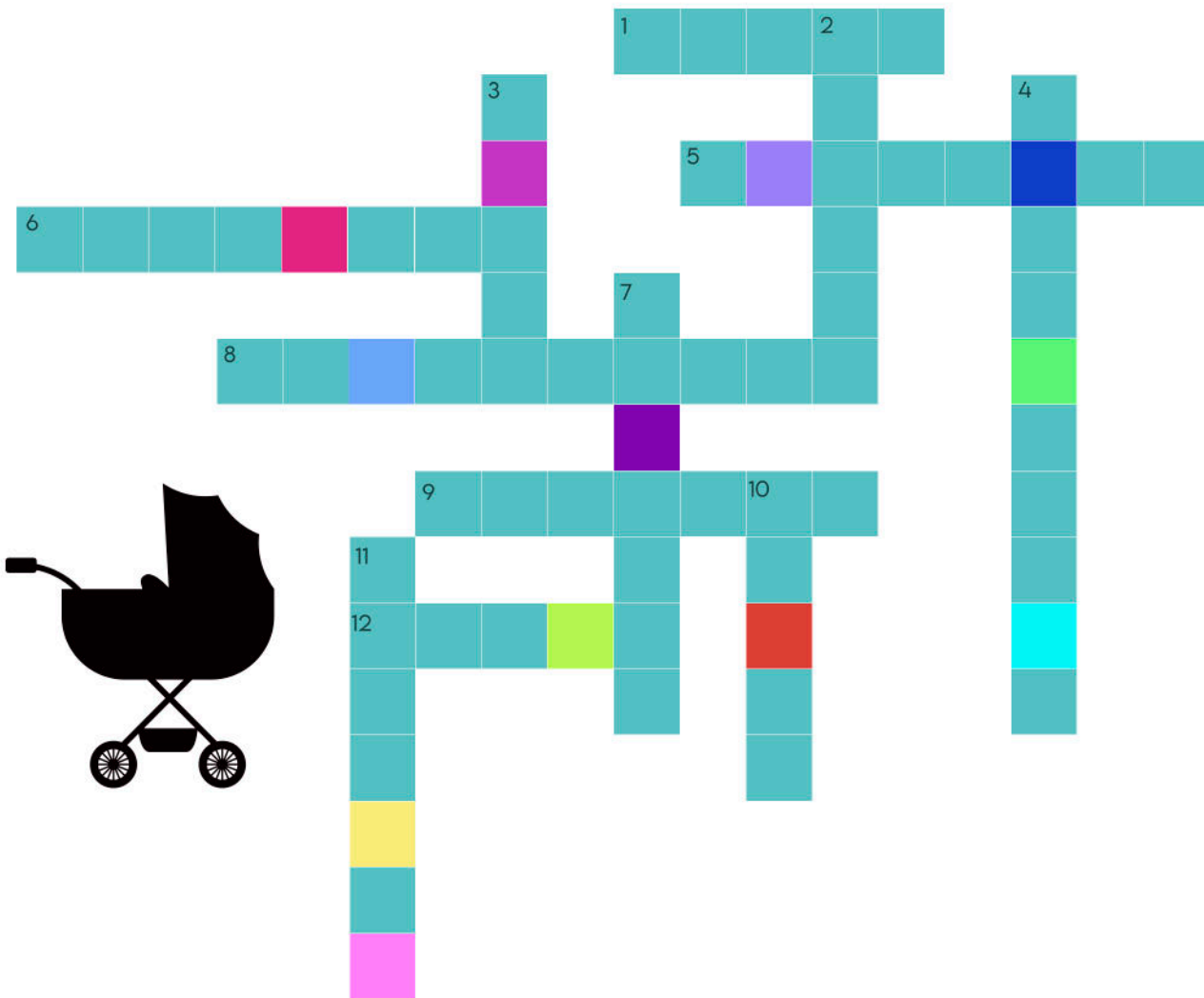
Guide your solvers to find both hidden rings and match them with the corresponding ring images to learn the 2nd digit to the combination lock.

# ANSWERS & SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS

**STEP 1:** Gather the necessary materials and cut out the printables as needed. Ensure that you have all of the supplies necessary to solve each of the puzzles.

**STEP 2:** Invite however many guests you'd like using the printable invitation. An ideal number for working together in a group is 4-6 people.

**STEP 3:** On the night of the group date, prepare with your spouse (or solo if they want to participate) the escape room area by completing the following:

1. Hang up or frame the display sign from page 2. Place it where it can be easily seen.
2. Wrap the glue stick wrap around a tube of glue. This will be needed to assemble the cubes from puzzle #1.
3. Hang up or frame the numbered Ring Display image from page 5.
4. Remove the 9 of hearts from a standard deck of face cards. Hide the rest of the deck (without the 9) somewhere in the room where it can be found. It does not need to be in an obvious location, but somewhere visible.
5. Place your antique key, OR your printable key, in the small lock box. Lock the box with your combination lock and ensure it is able to open with the combination 7 - 5 - 9. Hide this locked box in a very unique place.



**STEP 4:** Hide the remaining clues as needed.

**Puzzle #1** - Hide the 2 marked and unassembled cubes and the wrapped glue stick in all separate locations.

**Puzzle #2** - Hide the 2 cut out rings provided that reveal "5" as the second digit combination in separate locations.

**Puzzle #3** - Hide the crossword puzzle printable with the label "Puzzle #3 - Crossword Puzzle" cut off. Note: Once participants complete the puzzle, the rainbow colored letters should spell "MISSING HEART" in the boxes provided. This should lead them to the deck of cards where the 3rd digit of the combination, 9, is missing.

Ultimately, your guests' goal is to find the 3 numbers in order that will unlock your box and give them the key. If you want the game to go faster or be a little easier, you could tell them this ahead of time.
