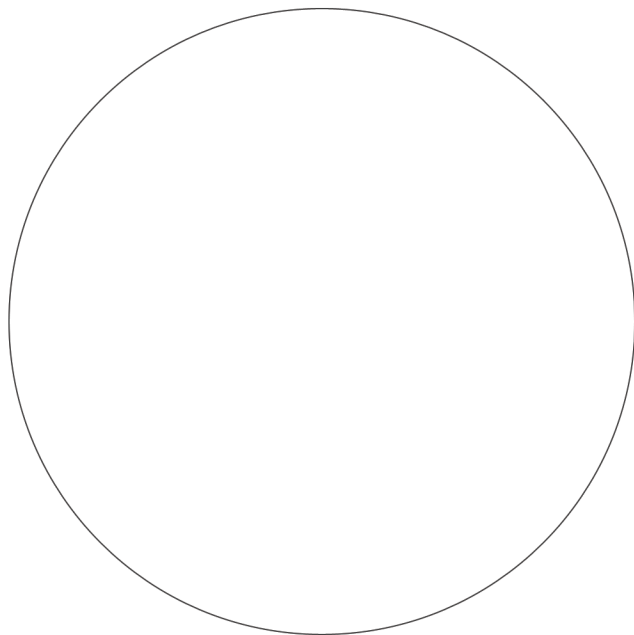

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out all the pieces on the solid black lines.
2. Attach the white circle tag behind the other circle tag with glue (or use pop dots to give it some dimension).
3. Fold the strips like an accordion along the dashed lines and glue both of the ends of the two strips together to make a circle.
4. Turn your circle and bring the middle together - hot glue and hold together until dry.
5. Hot glue the tag onto the front.
6. Cut a 6 1/2" piece of ribbon, fold in half and glue onto the back.
7. To finish, glue a bar pin on top of the ribbon.

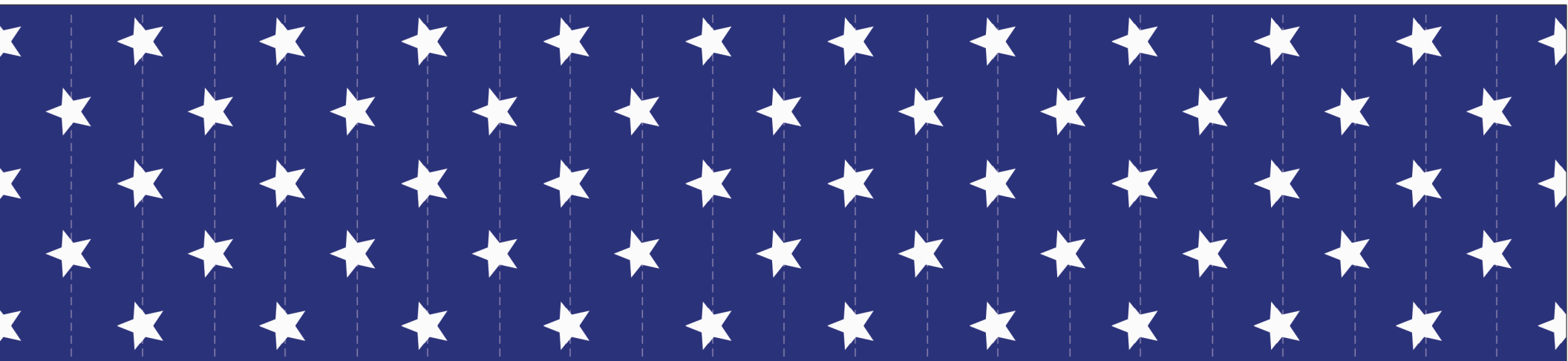
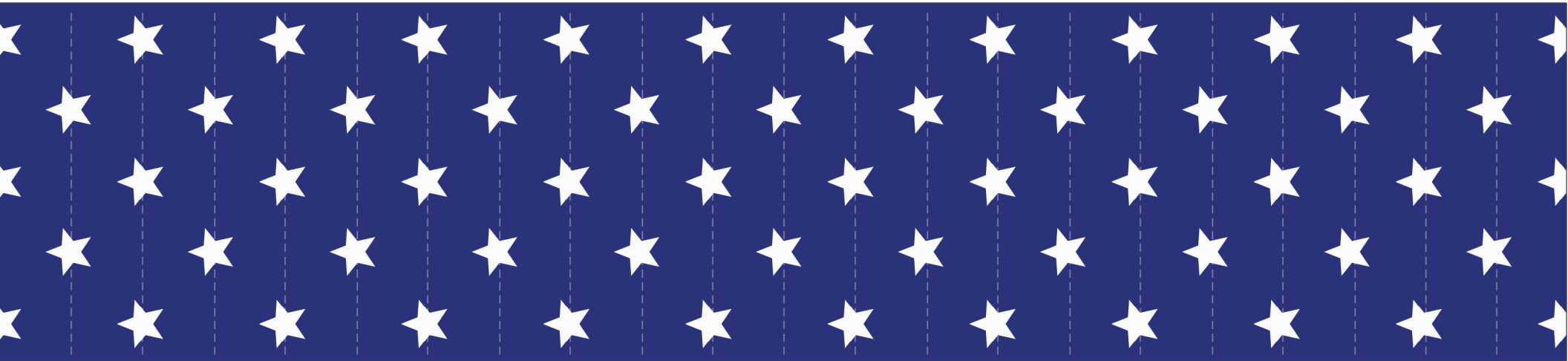

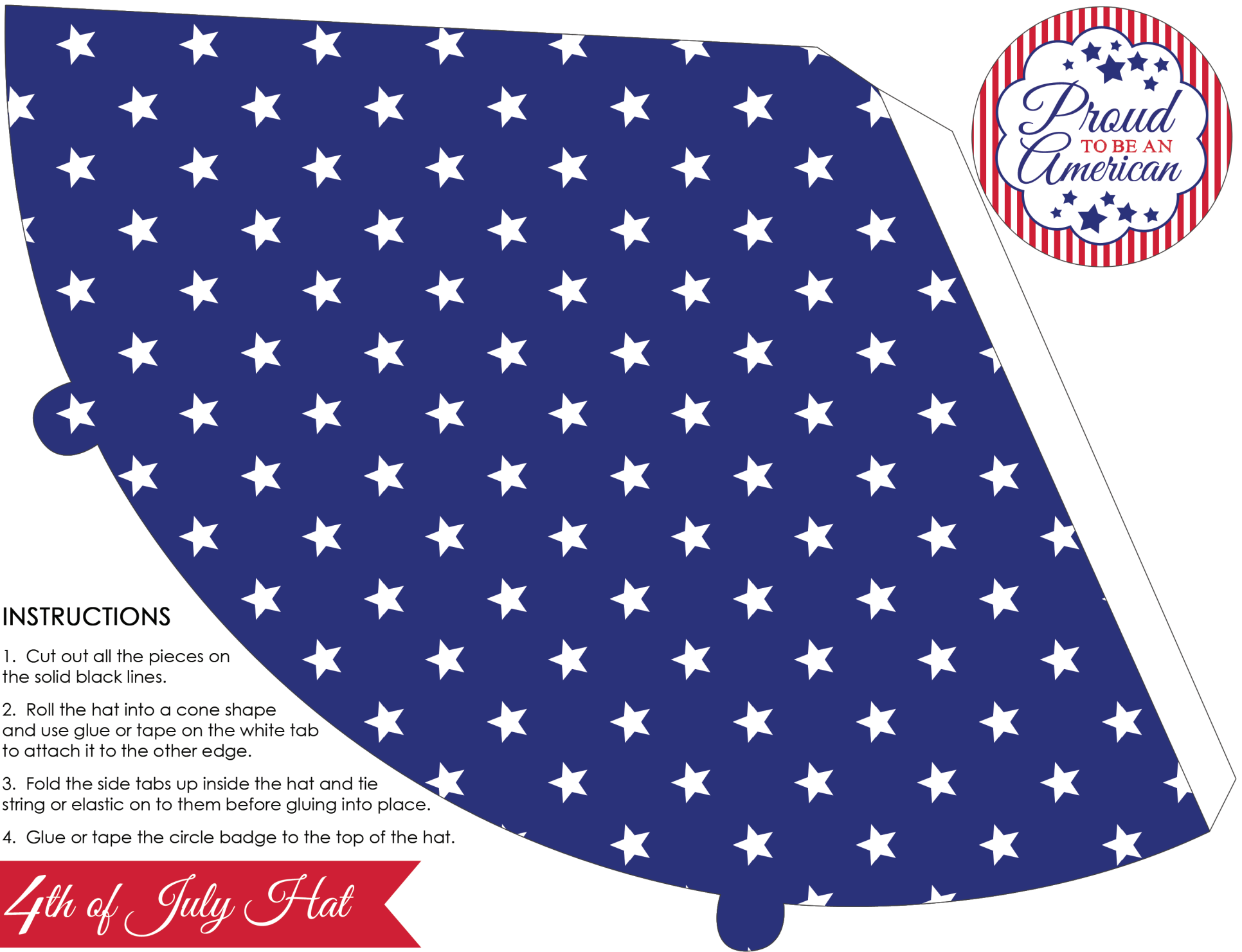

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out all the pieces on the solid black lines.
2. Roll the hat into a cone shape and use glue or tape on the white tab to attach it to the other edge.
3. Fold the side tabs up inside the hat and tie string or elastic on to them before gluing into place.
4. Glue or tape the circle badge to the top of the hat.
